PRESCRIBED BY HIGH COURT UNDER SECTION 11 OF THE ORISSA CIVIL COURTS ACT, 1984
(ORISSA ACT 18 OF 1984)

ALL SUNDAYS AND SECOND SATURDAY OF EACH MONTH

JANUARY

11th- DHANU JATRA: Only at Bargarh

12th & 13th—POUSA PURNIMA: In the Judgeships of Sambalpur, Deogarh, Bargarh, Jharsuguda. Only one day, i.e. 12th in the Judgeships of Balangir, Sonepur, Kalahandi, Nuapada, Sundaroarh & at Athamallik in the Judgeship of Angul.

> 13th— PONGAL: In the Judgeships of Ganjam, Gajapati, Koraput, Nabarangpur, Rayagada, Malkangiri, Mayurbhanj & Keonjhar except at Anandapur.

23rd- NETAJI JAYANTI

26th- REPUBLIC DAY

27th- BIRAJA SWANAKHETRA: In the Judgeship of Jajpur.

FERRUARY

1st- SARASWATI PUJA

3rd-MAGHA SAPTAMI: At Nimapara in the Judgeship of Puri.

7th— VYASA SAROBAR MELA/BHAIMI EKADASHI: At Jajpur Road in the Judgeship of Jajpur and at Khandapara in the Judgeship of Nayagarh.

10th- JORANDA MELA: In the Judgeship of Dhenkanal

24th— MAHA SHIVARATRI: One day more, i.e., 25th not to be observed in the Judgeships of Kendrapara, Kalahandi, Nuapada and at Nimapara in the Judgeship of Puri.

MARCH

13th-HOLI

14th & 15th— BADA JATRA/DAY FOLLOWING HOLI: In the Judgeship of Malkangiri. Only one day i.e., 14th at Salipur, Banki and Narasinghpur in the Judgeship of Cuttack.

> 17th— PANCHA DOLA: In the Judgeship of Kendrapara, at Banpur in the Judgeship of Khurda & at Ranpur in the Judgeship of Nayagarh. Day following Pancha Dola i.e., 18th only at Athagarh in the Judgeship of Cuttack.

> 25th— BARUNI GANGA SNANA: At Jajpur and Chandikhol in the Judgeship of Jajpur and at Anandapur in the Judgeship of Keonjhar.

> 28th— TELGU NEW YEAR'S DAY: In the Judgeships of Ganjam, Gajapati, Koraput, Nabarangpur, Rayagada & Malkangiri.

APRIL

1st--- UTKAL DIVAS

4th- SHREERAM NAVAMI/ASHOKASTAMI

11th— HINGULA JATRA/JHAMU JATRA: At Talcher in the Judgeship of Angul and at Nimapara in the Judgeship of Puri.

13th- LANKA PODI: At Daspalla in the Judgeship of Nayagarh

14th- MAHA BISUVA SANKRANTI/GOOD FRIDAY

28th- LAWYER'S DAY

29th— AKSHAYA TRUTIYA/DAY FOLLOWING CHANDAN JATRA: In the Judgeships of Balangir, Sonepur, Rayagada, Puri, Sambalpur, Deogarh, Bargarh, Jharsuguda, Sundargarh, at Badamba in the Judgeship of Cuttack and at Pallahara in the Judgeship of Angul.

MAY & JUNE

9th— NRUSINGHA CHATURDASHI: At Padampur & Sohella in the Judgeship of Bargarh

10th- BUDDHA PURNIMA: At Badamba in the Judgeship of Cuttack

22nd May— SUMMER VACATION: All the Courts in the Judgeships of Dhenkanal, to Ganjam, Gajapati, Koraput, Nabarangpur, Rayagada, Malkangiri, 17th June

Sambalpur, Deogarh, Bargarh, Jharsuguda on account of Savitri Amabasya and Sambalpur, Deogarh, Bargarh and Jharsuguda on account of Sital Sasthi and Koraput, Puri and at Salipur in the Judgeship of Cuttack on account of Snana Purnima shall be closed as per the date of observance of above festivals. All the Courts of the State shall remain closed on 14th.

26th June— DAY FOLLOWING RATHA JATRA/ID-UL-FITRE: Not to be observed in the Judgeships of Deogarh, Bargarh and Jharsuguda.

15th & 16th June on account of Raja Festival.

JULY

3rd — BAHUDA JATRA: One day more, i.e., 4th in the Judgeships of Kendrapara, Mayurbhanj, Puri except at Nimapara and at Tigiria in the Judgeship of Cuttack.

AUGUST

7th- SHRAVAN PURNIMA/LUNAR ECLIPSE

14th- JANMASTAMI

15th- INDEPENDENCE DAY

25th- GANESH PUJA

26th— NABANNA: In the Judgeships of Balangir, Sonepur, Kalahandi, Nuapada, Keonjhar, Mayurbhanj, Phulbani, Boudh, Sambalpur, Deogarh, Bargarh, Jharsuguda, Sundargarh, Jagatsinghpur and Cuttack except at Badamba.

SEPTEMBER

2nd— ID-UZ-ZUHA: Not to be observed in the Judgeships of Balangir, Jagatsinghpur, Dhenkanal, Keonjhar, Rayagada, Mayurbhanj, Puri & Deogarh.

4th- GANESH IMMERSION DAY: At Talcher in the Judgeship of Angul.

5th- ANANTA BRATA: At Barpalli in the Judgeship of Bargarh.

13th- DUTI BAMAN OSHA: In the Judgeship of Balangir

19th- MAHALAYA

27th to 6th — DURGA PUJA VACATION: (Including Gandhi Jayanti on 2nd and October Kumar Pumima on 5th October).

OCTOBER

16th—GAJALAXMI IMMERSION DAY: In the Judgeships of Kendrapara, Dhenkanal and at Angul only.

19th— KALI PUJA/DEEPAVALI: One day more, i.e., 20th in the Judgeships of Balasore, Bhadrak, Jajpur, Angul, Nuapada, Keonjhar, Mayurbhanj, Phulbani, Boudh, Puri, Nayagarh and Khurda except at Banpur.

30th— KARTIKA LAST MONDAY: Not to be observed in the Judgeships of Balangir, Sonepur, Cuttack, Jagatsinghpur, Kendrapara, Jajpur, Dhenkanal, Malkangiri, Mayurbhanj, Sambalpur, Deogarh, Bargarh, Jharsuguda & Sundargarh.

NOVEMBER

2nd— DHABALESWAR PUJA/BADA OSHA: In the Judgeships of Cuttack, Jagatsinghpur, Kendrapara, Dhenkanal, Keonjhar and Deogarh. One day more, i.e., 3rd in the Judgeships of Jagatsinghpur, Dhenkanal and at Cuttack Sadar only.

4th- RASA PURNIMA

30th— MANABASA GURUBAR: Not to be observed in the Judgeships of Cuttack, Kendrapara, Jajpur, Keonjhar, Malkangiri, Sambalpur, Bargarh & at Talcher in the Judgeship of Angul.

DECEMBER

2nd— BIRTHDAY OF PROPHET MOHAMMED: In the Judgeships of Balasore, Bhadrak, Cuttack, Jagatsinghpur, Kendrapara, Jajpur, Kalahandi, Khurda and at Nayagarh only.

25th- X-MAS DAY

28th to 30th-WINTER HOLIDAYS

N.B.— (i) The District and Sessions Judges of the State are authorised to change the date of local festivals (other than common holidays) as per the date of observance, if necessary.

(iii) As Makar Sankranti (14th January), & Prathamastami (11th November) fall on 2nd Saturdays and New Year's Day (1st January), Samba Dasami (8th January), Dola Purnima (12th March), Ratha Jatra (25th June), Chitalagi Amabasya (23rd July), Sunia (3rd September), Biswakarma Puja (17th September) & Moharrum (1st October) fall on Sundays, those days have not been mentioned in the list of holidays.
