Ans: In Nabarangpur Block there is 1 (One) District Head Quarter Hospital, 1 (One) Community Health Centre, 02 no. of primary health center & 23 nos. of Sub Center situated in the Block. There are 1 (One) no. Private Health Care i.e. Christian Hospital situated at Gadabaguda. In D.H.H., Nabarangpur there are 1 nos. of Covid Hospital along with 2nos. of Ambulance facility available in the block.

2. How Many RT PCR and Rapid Antigen kits are available in the Block:

Ans: As on date 500 Nos. of RT PCR kits & 600 nos. of Antigen test kits are available in the Nabarangpur Head Quarter Hospital & in Christian Hospital there is no such test facilities are available.

No such testing facilities are available in Christian Hospital, Nabarangpur.

Ans: As far as ground reality for payment of cost of the tests are concerned, the CHC is a Govt establishment there is no cost levied on individuals / persons for being tested either for RT PCR or for Rapid Antigen test, it is free of cost. As there is no private Health facility is available in the Block area to conduct either RT PCR or Rapid Antigen tests no amount of price is being collected.



- NOTE: 1. MOI/c was highly appreciating the service provided during COVID Pannademic by MHU, and RBSK staff also shouldered there responsibility.
 - 2. During field visit at remote area found MHU Chandahandi
 - 3. While interacting with staff it was came to our notice that Covid Worriers (MHU and RBSK) moral is bit low because of irregularity in their Rapid Response Team (RRT) Covid Incentive. Discussed this issue with MOI/c and found that matter is pending at DHH. Initiative may be taken up by paying Covid Worrier dues, so that they are Boosted Morally in tern local public / Government is being benefitted.
 - 4. Public opinion for ambulance services is to have more ambulances/102/108 for their services as they are getting delayed services by ambulance some times.
 - 5. People were not interested and they feared to come forward for RT PCR test. Hence it is recommonded that ASHA / Health Workers must be motivated(by paying Incentives) for encouraging the villagers for RT PCR test.
 - 6. Its also observed that people face difficulty for their diagnosis tests as all diagnosis are done at Community Health Center only. Hence its requested that Health ATM's may be installed at remote places so that initial stage generic diagnosis can be monitored/ controlled by respective Health ATM's.
